Perth Tutors and Assistant Tutors/Venue Managers – part-time positions

After 27 years on the east coast, the Australian Girls Choir opened with great success in Perth in July 2011. Due to unprecedented demand for classes in 2012, we are now searching for more energetic and motivated Singing Teachers with a broad Performing Arts education and youthful, organised Assistant Tutors/Venue Managers to assist and administrate the classes.

The Australian Girls Choir currently operates in Adelaide, Brisbane, Melbourne, Sydney and Perth with over 3,500 girls in training. In 2012 we are running classes in Subiaco and Duncraig for more than 300 girls aged 5 to 13 years. Our innovative approach to the choir model, and professional standards of performance, requires staff who are energetic, spontaneous and flexible.

All teaching hours and rehearsals are paid; applicants must be available for work on Saturday mornings between 9.00am – 12.00 noon during school terms. The positions will commence immediately.

Staff must be able to participate well in a team, but also have their own sense of performing identity and teaching practice. Many find that working with ASPA complements their performance practice, enhances their career, and contributes to their own personal sense of enjoyment.

No experience is required for the Assistant Tutor/Venue Manager position. This is a more junior role which often suits a young person with an interest in the arts/education. Assistant Tutors/Venue Managers are responsible for the smooth running of the rehearsal venue, liaising with parents, assisting the tutors in class, ensuring the safety of the choristers and representing the choir in this public forum.

Teaching applicants must have Music and Performing Arts experience and/or educational qualifications; excellent presentation, well developed communication and interpersonal skills and a passion for the performing arts are essential for both roles.
